How does an E-ssessment work?

- Request/inquire through facebook or email (bri9c@aol.com).
- Choose an appointment day/time.
- The cost is \$40 per E-ssessment. \$100 maximum per family. Make the paypal payment at least 48 hours prior to your appointment.
- Work samples are transmitted through the postal service or electronically and are to be received within 3 business days of the appointment.
- After we "meet" on the phone, an "Academic Assessment Report" form is sent electronically or through USPS. This is the form for the school district.

Questions and Answers:

What do I need to send to you?

Prepare a document that is a "snapshot" of your school year. Possibly include a list of curriculum used, field trips/extra curricula. Include samples of composition (preferably at different times in the school year so progress can be noted). Send examples (daily work or tests) of math, history, science, spelling and language arts. Also feel free to include any challenges or issues you may be experiencing if you would like suggestions. An outline is included below that may be helpful.

What will the phone conversation entail?

I will call you at our scheduled time. Please allow 45 minutes per student, depending on how many questions or special situations you may have. Documents will be viewed as we chat on the phone. Questions are encouraged! It is my job to offer encouragement, suggestions and support to you as your child's educator.

Is this really legitimate?

HSLDA has confirmed that this is a viable way to conduct assessments. Please understand that I will not simply give away my signature- I do need each e-ssessment client to follow the procedures above to show that the student is making forward progress.
